IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ THIS DISCLOSURE FORM ANDTHE ENCLOSED VIATICAL SETTLEMENT INFORMATION BROCHURE BEFORE THE SIGNING OF ANY VIATICAL SETTLEMENT CONTRACT BY ALL PARTIES. You should carefully read all of the following points and seek financial, insurance, tax and other advice where appropriate.

- 1. There exist possible alternatives to a viatical settlement contract, including any accelerated death benefits or policy loans offered under the viator's life insurance policy.
- 2. Some or all of the proceeds of the viatical settlement contract may be taxable under federal income tax and state franchise and income taxes, and assistance may be sought from a professional tax advisor.
- 3. Proceeds of the viatical settlement contract may be subject to the claims of creditors.
- 4. Receipt of the proceeds of a viatical settlement contract may adversely affect the viator's eligibility for medicaid or other government benefits or entitlements, and advice may be obtained from the appropriate government agencies.
- 5. The viator has the right to rescind a viatical settlement contract before the earlier of thirty calendar days after the date upon which the viatical settlement contract is executed by all parties or fifteen calendar days after the receipt of the viatical settlement proceeds by the viator. Rescission, if exercised by the viator, is effective only if both notice of the rescission is given and repayment of all proceeds and any premiums, loans, and loan interest to the viatical settlement provider is made within forty-five days after the end of the rescission period. If the insured dies during the rescission period, the viatical settlement contract is deemed to have been rescinded, subject to repayment of all viatical settlement proceeds and any premiums, loans, and loan interest being made to the viatical settlement provider within the rescission period.
- 6. Funds must be sent to the viator within three business days after the viatical settlement provider has received the insurer's or group administrator's acknowledgment that ownership of the viaticated policy has been transferred and the beneficiary has been designated.
- 7. Entering into a viatical settlement contract may cause other rights or benefits, including conversion rights and waiver of premium benefits that may exist under the policy, to be forfeited by the viator, and that the viator may seek assistance from an independent financial adviser.
- 8.
